Winland Foods joined Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO) in 2023, an organization dedicated to promoting the growth and use of sustainable palm oil products through credible global standards and the engagement of stakeholders. Winland Foods supports the principles of the RSPO and their efforts to encourage and certify sustainable palm oil production practices.

Winland Foods began sourcing certified sustainable palm oil through purchase of RSPO Mass Balance supply chain models in 2013. Winland Foods sources palm oil from suppliers who are RSPO members and are in good standing.

To achieve this goal, our manufacturing plants which source and use Palm oil and Palm oil materials have been RSPO Supply Chain certified to source, use and make claims.

We are striving to fulfill demands of our customers and consumers to advance the use of RSPO CSPO through internal awareness and engagement with our suppliers of palm oil. Our suppliers play a critical role and we are encouraging them to develop and provide sustainable and cost-effective supply of RSPO CSPO fractions and derivatives.

Additionally, we support practices to help achieve zero net deforestation and support smallholders. Our goal is all Winland Foods suppliers to source palm oil based on following principals by 2025.

- 1. Compliance with RSPO Principles (or equivalent).*
- 2. Protection of High Conservation Value (HCV) and High Carbon Stock (HCS) forests.*
- 3. No new development on peatlands and the use of Best Management Practices for existing plantations on peatlands.*
- 4. Commitment to no-burn policies.*
- 5. Commitment to traceable and transparent palm oil supply.*
- 6. Respect for human rights, including the right to free, prior and informed consent, for community stakeholders impacted by expansion.*
- 7. Support for the integration of smallholders into sustainable supply chains.*
- 8. Compliance with Winland Foods Inc.'s Social Responsibility policy and all applicable international, national and local laws and regulations.*
